TWO PONDS NATURE AREA HIKING TRAILS & NATURE STUDY

- Park at the trailhead, at the junction of Hidden Lake Road and Fox Run Road.
- Explore 95 acres of town-owned woodland, located between Saturday Pond and Moose Pond, with frontage on both ponds.
- 1.7 miles of hiking trails round trip. The Saturday Pond Trail starts at the trailhead and, with the Saturday Pond Loop Trail and back, is 1.5 miles. The Moose Pond Trail is .2 miles there and back.
- Saturday Pond Trail includes 1200 feet along the shore of Saturday Pond.
- Trails connect Moose Pond to Saturday Pond for XC Skiing. (Not groomed.)
